Governor Chafee to kick off tax amnesty

PROVIDENCE – Rhode Island Governor Lincoln D. Chafee will officially launch Rhode Island's tax amnesty program at a news conference tomorrow – Wednesday, August 29 – at 4 p.m. at the State House's State Room.

As a result of legislation approved by the General Assembly and signed into law by Governor Chafee on June 15, Rhode Island is offering a 75-day tax amnesty period, from September 2 through November 15, 2012.

The amnesty includes incentives to encourage those who have fallen behind on their taxes to pay what they owe.

In addition to Governor Chafee, state Revenue Director Rosemary Booth Gallogly and state Tax Administrator David M. Sullivan are also scheduled to attend the news conference and will be available afterward to answer questions.
